Vinification	Alcoholic fermentation begins in stainless steel tanks then transferred to American and French oak barrels.
Vineyards	The soil is influenced by the Atlantic and the Mediterranean and consists of chalky and clayey soils.
Tasting Notes	Bright deep plum color. Seductive on the nose with spiced character and notes of tobacco. Aroma of clove, rosemary, thyme, and cocoa give way to fragrant black fruits and menthols. Silky and Elegant. Fruity character with plum, spice, chocolate, and liquorice standing out.
