



## Rueda 2014

<b>Region</b>	Rioja
<b>Winemaker</b>	Beatriz Paniagua and Matias Calleja
<b>Grape Type</b>	100% Verdejo
<b>Production</b>	10,000 cases
<b>Alcohol</b>	13%
<b>Vinification</b>	A wine produced from two different harvests in the same vineyard. An early harvest with fermentation at high temps in order to achieve an explosion of aromas. Then a second harvest fermentated at lower temps looking for maturity, more concentration and complexity. The resulting wine is a blend of the two distinct winemaking techniques to achieve an aromatic wine which is fresh, flavorsome and, at the same time, complex.
<b>Vineyards</b>	After a year of research this unique verdejo vineyard was selected in the heart of Rueda. Typical cascajosos soil unique to the región. Stony soils that absorb the heat during the day and release during the night. Well ventilated, rich in calcium and magnesium with excellent drainage, giving maximum complexity to the grape
<b>Tasting Notes</b>	Bright, pale yellow color with hints of green. An intense nose with aromas of ripe stone fruits and aromatic herbs, with floral touches, fennel and freshly cut grass. Full fruit and dry with a long finish, the wine has a balanced acidity and an attractive bitterness that is characteristic of the varietal.



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
